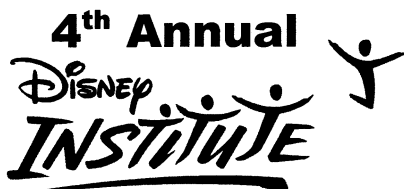

Payment Policy: A \$200 deposit is required within 14 days of booking your reservation and full payment will be required 30 days prior to arrival date.

Cancellation Policy: Cancellations made within 29 days from event start will forfeit \$200. Cancellations made within 5 days from event start will forfeit \$200 plus one night of hotel room charge and tax.

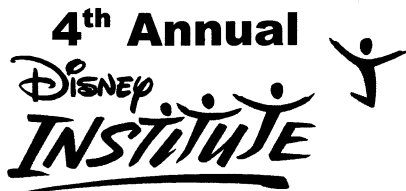
Transportation: Transportation to and from Disney Institute is available from a variety of shuttle, taxi and limousine services. If traveling by airplane, it is recommended that you land at Orlando International Airport no later than 2 p.m. on Tuesday, July 24, and arrange for a departure after 3:30 p.m. on Sunday, July 29.

Directions to Disney Institute from Orlando International Airport: Take toll road 417 South to the International Drive exit (Exit #6). Continue straight on that road for approximately one mile and you will come to our Welcome to Walt Disney World® Resort gateway. After the gateway, take the third exit, marked Downtown Disney Resort Area: Old Key West, Port Orleans, Disney Institute, and Golf Courses. As you exit, proceed straight through the traffic signal onto Community Drive for approximately one mile. You will pass Disney's Old Key West Resort and pass through a golf course. The Disney Institute entrance will be on your right, marked by a stone wall and welcome kiosk.

Disney Institute is located in the heart of the Walt Disney World Resort near Orlando, Florida, and adjacent to Downtown Disney. You'll enjoy the small-town warmth and charm of buildings designed around a town green, nestled in an intimate lakeside setting. Throughout our campus, you'll find world-class facilities including a full-service spa and fitness center, broadcast-quality performance center, clay tennis courts and an 18-hole championship golf course. Golf carts and bicycles are available to rent on an hourly or daily basis. Should you wish to visit other areas of the Walt Disney World Resort during your stay, bus transportation services are provided throughout our "World" at no additional cost to Disney Institute Guests.

Accommodations: Your check-in time at Disney Institute is 4 p.m. and check-out is at 11 a.m. Guest Registration is located in the Welcome Center.

Program Attire is casual for all functions including dinner on Tuesday, July 24.
